**MINUTES OF THE PENSION ADALAT HELD ON 08.02.2017  
UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF HON'BLE CHIEF COMMISSIONER**

As per the office memorandum issued vide F.No.C-30013/77/2014-Ad.IVA dated 09.02.2017 issued by the Government of India, Department of Revenue, Central Board of Excise and Customs, New Delhi for pension and other retirement related benefits of Central Government employees covered under CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972 and also for promoting pensioners welfare and for serving as a forum for the redressal of pensioners grievances, the Pension Adalat for Vadodara cluster was held on 08.02.2017 at Headquarter's office of Vadodara-II Commissionerate.

2. The Pension Adalat was chaired by Shri Arvind Singh, Chief Commissioner, Central Excise, Customs & Service Tax, Vadodara Zone. The Chairman welcomed all retired and serving officer in the Pension Adalat.
3. The Pension Adalat was held in the Conference Hall at 1<sup>st</sup> Floor of Vadodara-II Commissionerate in which the following officers participated:

The following cases were discussed:-

### VADODARA-I

**Case No.1:** The payment of arrears of Pension and Family pension of Rs.3,13,963/- has still not been paid to Shri Amol Rakhe, s/o Late Smt. Mohini G.Rakhi, O.S.

In this regard, CAO, Vadodara-I informed that the Pr. Commissioner Vadodara-I on 22.07.2016 has sanctioned an amount of Rs. 3,13,963/- as arrears of family pension and the payment has been credited in the bank account of Sri Amol G.Rakhe, holder of PPO No.509829400522 nominee of Late Smt Mohini G.Rakhi(O.S., Retd.).

**Hence, the case was considered as decided.**

**Case No.2:** Shri Digambar K.Baxi, Tax Assistant(Retd.) submitted that he has not received the revised pension under 7<sup>th</sup> CPC. The PPO Book with Photo has still not been received by him.

The Pay and Accounts Officer, Vadodara has promised that the revised pension would be settled within three days. As regards to PPO, the pensioner was requested to contact the Branch Manager of the pension receiving bank since the CPAO, New Delhi had already forwarded two copies (Bank's as well as Pensioner's copy) to the Bank on 26.07.2016.

**Case No.3:** Shri Satish H.Thakar, Superintendent(Retd.) aggrieved that the Departmental proceedings was held vide Charge Memorandum issued vide F.No.II/8(vig)6/2007 dated 21.11.2007 and addendum dated 10.07.2008 and the case has not yet been decided even after a lapse of 9 years. Also all his benefits have been held up.

Shri S.K.Singh, Joint Commissioner, Vadodara-I informed that his case papers have been received back vide Board's letter 26.10.2016 wherein certain queries have been raised by Ad.V. Compliance will be sent to Board's Office for deciding his case quickly.

**Case No.4:-** Shri Rathwa Maganbhai Dalsighbha, Superintendent(Retd.) (Was not present in the Pension Adalat) His grievance was that the PPO has still not been received.

The pensioner was requested to contact the Branch Manager of the pension receiving bank. Since, this pertained to Bank, it was requested that the Pensioner may contact the Branch Manager of the Pension Receiving Bank.

### VADODARA-II

**Case No.5:-** Shri Tamboli (H/o Smt. K.P.Tamboli, Sr.T.A. (Retd.)) , wherein she has not received the PPO. The representative of SBI Bank (Ajwa Road), who was present in the Adalat, informed that they too had not received the PPO.

The Bank Manager(SBI, Ajwa Road) was requested to contact the CPAO, New Delhi for compliance.

**Case No.6:-** The final case was of Shri K.I.Vashi, Superintendent(Retd.) who was not paid Gratuity, non commutation of pension, did not get ACP grade from 5400 to 6600,

did not get reward for silver case booked in the year 1993 as his departmental inquiry is still pending.

Shri K.I. Vashi was informed that his disciplinary case is still pending with Ad.V, CBEC, New Delhi, who have recently sent back his inquiry file to the Commissionerate for General Examination under Rule 14 (18) of CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965. An order to this effect has already been issued by the Principal Commissioner, CCE, Vadodara-II, a copy of which is also endorsed to Shri Vashi for further process. On receipt of report from Inquiry Officer, the file will be re-submitted to CBEC for final orders.

The Pay & Accounts Officer, Central Excise & Customs, Vadodara has raised some points:-

1. Non availability of nomination papers of Pensioners in Service Book :-


A point was raised by Shri K.G. Mathew, Pay and Accounts Officer, Central Excise, Customs and Service Tax, Vadodara regarding non availability of nomination papers of Pensioners in Service Book. Therefore, it was desired that all the DDOs should be instructed to verify all the service books and ensure that nominations are obtained from all the officers and kept in the service books. In addition, it was also desired that one copy of (i) Aadhar Card, (ii) Contact mobile number of the nominees (iii) present residential address may also be obtained and kept in the service book.

2. Updation of Bhavishya

Bhavishya is Pension Sanction & Payment Tracking system initiated by the Department of Pension & Pensioner's Welfare, New Delhi. It was suggested by one of the members of the Pension Adalat that a training may be arranged for all the DDO's through a private party at Vadodara. A software has been developed by the Department of Pension & Pensioner's Welfare, which can be accessed at Bhavishya.nic.in & its use is mandatory w.e.f. 01.01.2017.

The meeting ended after expressing sincere thanks to the Hon'ble Chief Commissioner, Central Excise, Customs & Service Tax, Vadodara Zone for presiding over the Pension Adalat, to all members of the adalat and to all representatives.
